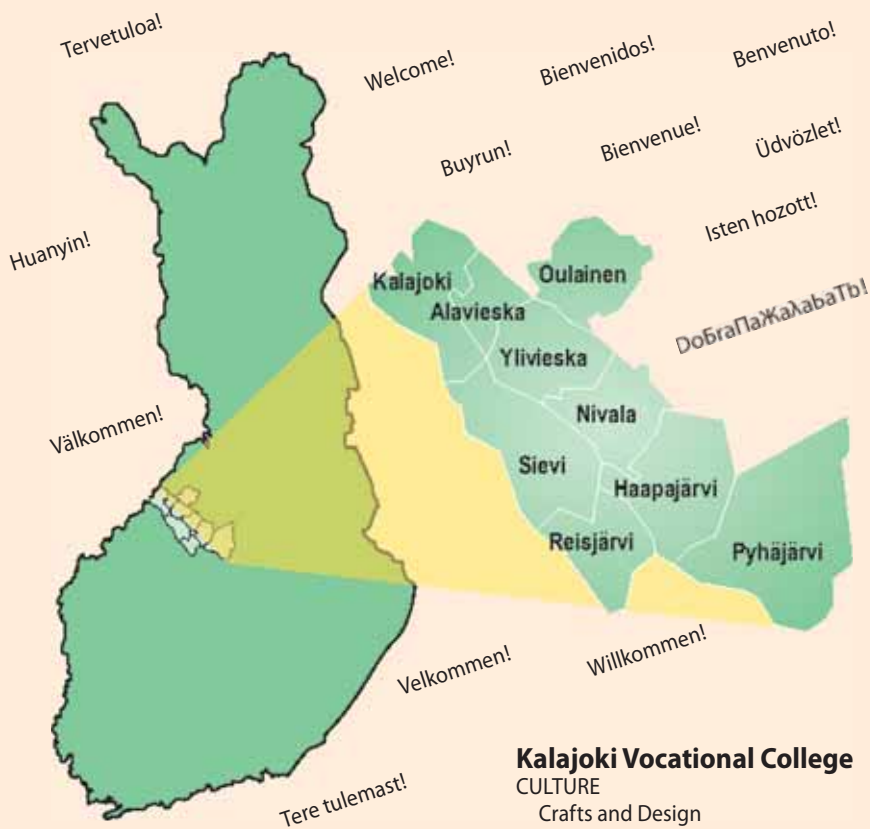

KAM is owned by nine towns: Alavieska, Haapajärvi, Kalajoki, Nivala, Oulainen, Pyhäjärvi, Reisjärvi, Sievi and Ylivieska. The Administrative office is located in Nivala. KAM also owns a Driving Academy.

The towns along the River Kalajoki in Central Finland form a remarkable region. Kalajokilaakso Region is internationally known for its agricultural production as well as for its wood processing and metal industry. There are about 70.000 inhabitants in this area. KAM has about 3000 students, 215 teachers and 140 other staff members. The school year in Finland is usually from middle of August until the end of May.

All the study programmes last 3 years. After acquiring one of these qualifications, you can start your working career. But these qualifications also give you a general opportunity for getting further education, e.g. in vocational colleges, polytechnics and universities.

The students have also the possibility of taking the Matriculation examination.

The strategy for international activities

In the federation's strategy for international activities the educational objective is to increase the participation of the students and staff in the international interaction.

The federation is willing to increase and develop the knowledge of different languages and cultures which is required in the internationalising working life.

In adult education internationality is increased, and it is directed according to the labour needs in small and medium-sized companies, and especially in export business.

The objective of the federation is to develop international working life connections and to increase cultural knowledge, and to get internationally comparable information with the help of mutual projects.

The students achieve the learning results set in the curricula and in the qualifications of the vocational skills demonstrations. The employees of the federation are well-motivated and qualified. The financial standing of the federation is in balance. The structure of vocational colleges in KAM provides the good preconditions to develop the area comprehensively.

Internationalization

Students of the vocational colleges of the Educational Municipal Federation of the Kalajokilaakso Region can partially get education at educational institutions and businesses abroad, thanks to our international cooperation. The Educational institutions are working in cooperation with other colleges on the international scale, e.g. in China, Denmark, Estonia, Hungary, Poland, Slovenia, Russian, Spain, Sweden, Turkey and United Kingdom. The colleges are constantly developing different forms of cooperation with schools and colleges from different countries.

On-the-job training and skills tests

On-the-job training is part of education included in getting the vocational qualification. On-the-job training is based on setting up the goal and working out the educational plan to suit the individual and tutorial system of education. The duration of the on-the-job training is at least 20 units, i.e. about half a year, and it could be realized in one or several periods, and at different jobs. The training periods can be scheduled in any phase on the whole education process. A student is to get some of the professional skills of qualification at the job and is ready to meet the needs of the labour market and gets a better possibility to become employed.

Skills tests denote skills demonstrations and arrangements, realised together with working life, with which the show how well they have reached the goals of the professional studies and the professionalism required in working life.

The skills tests became a part of the studies in 2006. Within the basic vocational certificate the skills tests are a part of the evaluation of the student. The demonstrations take place throughout the training and are given for all vocational study modules.

The student gets a separate diploma for the skills test, and this diploma is attached to the degree diploma. For students, vocational skills demonstrations make it easier to get a job.



Kalajoki Vocational College ARTEMA



Kalajoki, on the northern reaches of Gulf of Bothnia, is a dynamic town of 9500 people, well known for its superb sandy beaches. For students, Kalajoki offers a wide choice of leisure activities, from special courses to sport.

STUDY PROGRAMMES

The College has arts, crafts and design courses in four major subjects: metal, wood, building and clothing.

In the College there is also one study programme exclusively for adults: interior design consultant programme.

Vocational Qualification in Crafts and Design, Artisan

An artisan's diploma requires 2,5 – 3,0 years (120 credits). The basic diploma provides entrance qualifications for colleges of higher education and polytechnics.

The training programme is versatile, flexible and extensive. The manufacturing process, from ideas, product development, design and material choices to ready products, including marketing and sales, is part of the courses.

Artisan's work is based on the traditions of old craftsmen using modern techniques. The training emphasizes versatility, creativity, independence, initiative, co-operation, manual skills and pre-



cision. A true artisan has a good command of form, colour, space and proportion and individual sense of style.

Vocational Qualification in Tourism

In Kalajokki Vocational College ARTEMA you can also study the basic diploma in travel industry.

The studies take 2,5 – 3,0 years (120 credits). If you have good interaction and language skills you should apply for this training.

The producer of travel services operates in travel business. In addition to accommodation and catering services they provide programs which involve nature, culture, health services, recreation and physical exercise.

The unit of tourism also has a study programme for those who want to become travel agents, desk clerks or work for transportation agencies. The graduated students are qualified to work at hotels, travel agencies, traffic companies and other companies in travel industry.

Students of travel industry have an option of 3 – 5 credits of art, crafts and design studies.

Haapajärvi Vocational College HAI



Haapajärvi is a rural town situated by the lake of Haapajärvi and the river of Kalajoki. It is a commercial centre with strong mechanical wood processing industry and modern agriculture specialized in milk production. The population of Haapajärvi is 8000.

Haapajärvi Vocational College (HAI) is a multifield college with modern facilities. It has 280 students in two departments: business and administration department and agricultural and forestry department. The business department of Ylivieska Unit of Central Ostrobothnia University of Applied Sciences with 100 students and Centria, a unit of research, development and further education, are also located on the same campus of Haapajärvi Vocational College. The Rural Development Centre offers education in vocational qualifications and short courses for hundreds of adult people and organize rural development projects. The college is also involved in extensive international cooperation and projects.

The school farm is specialized in milk production, automation and bioenergy. The school farm consists of 90 ha fields and 250 ha forests and has modern agricultural machines and a new cowshed with modern technology like milking robots, automatic feeders, a biogas plant and a biodiesel plant. Gas produced of cow manure is used in the cars of the college and in heating the school buildings. Biodiesel made of rapeoil is used in the cars and the tractors of the college. The VMS Training Centre of Finland with the newest models of milking robots is situated in the school farm. The horse stable and the manege of the college are located near the trotting area and offer good opportunities for equine students. The college has also modern harvesters and forwarders by which the forestry students learn the cut-to-length method as well as energy wood harvesting in forests own by the college, private forest owners or the state.

There is modern IT-technology available in the college and exhibitions organized by the college and the students. The business students will become specialists in customer services, marketing and business administration and IT-students in IT-technology and marketing. The agricultural students for example will go on farming in their farms of their own or work as rural entrepreneurs, holiday substitutes for the farmers or workers in the dairy or horse farms or in agricultural companies. The forestry students take care the forests, multi-purpose of the forests and the nature and work in different jobs in wood harvesting.

Nivala Vocational College NAO



Nivala Vocational College (NAO) offers education in two towns, Nivala and Pyhäjärvi. NAO is a multifield vocational college with about 800 students. All study programmes last 3 years. NAO provides education in 16 study programmes.

STUDY PROGRAMMES

Vocational Qualification in Vehicle Technology, Vehicle Mechanic

Study Programme in Vehicle Technology

Vehicle Mechanics work at automotive dealerships or accessory shops, repair shops or service stations in servicing, maintenance and repair and customer service. They may also be employed in the automotive industry or enterprises that manufacture special vehicles or vehicle body structures.

Vocational Qualification in Logistics, Driver

Study Programme in Transportation Services

Drivers work as drivers of vehicles and as assistants in different logistics transportation assignments. They are familiar with the structure of the vehicle and are able to load, handle and service the vehicle correctly.

Vocational Qualification in Metalwork and Machinery, Machinist Vocational Qualification in Metalwork and Machinery, Plater-welder

Study Programme in Manufacturing Technology

Machinists work in metalwork and machinery assignments, such as turning and milling work.

Plater-welders work in particular in those metalwork and machinery assignments that involve plate work and welding. They may also specialize in sheet-metal engineering technology.

Vocational Qualification in Building Maintenance Technology, Heating, Plumbing and Ventilation Fitter

Study Programme in Heating, Plumbing and Ventilation Engineering

Heating, plumbing and ventilation fitters work on construction sites or within properties as pipe fitters, ventilation fitters, property maintenance operatives, heating, plumbing and ventilation



insulators, ventilation sheet-metal workers, heating equipment fitters, district heating fitters, industrial pipe fitters, refrigeration fitters etc.

Vocational Qualification in Electrical Engineering, Electronics Assembler

Vocational Qualification in Electrical Engineering, Electrician
Study Programme in Electrical Engineering and Energy Technology

Electronics assemblers work in installation, servicing and production assignments within electronics production, information technology and telecommunications. The work may also include maintenance of consumer electronics and customer service. Electricians work in installation, maintenance and repair assignments, in energy production, transfer and supply assignments as well as in the electrical engineering industry and enterprises.

Vocational Qualification in Construction, Builder
Vocational Qualification in Construction, Stone Builder
Study Programme in Construction

Builders work on construction sites as carpenters, masons, tilers, concrete workers, steel fixers or construction workers. Stone builders work in processing and installation assignments on construction sites, including environmental construction.

Vocational Qualification in Wood Processing, Joiner
Study Programme in Joinery

Joiners work in positions in the joinery and construction industries or as independent craftspeople repairing and making furniture and other wooden products.

Vocational Qualification in Hairdressing Study, Hairdresser
Study Programme in Hairdressing

Hairdressers work as hairdressers and barbers and in sales, consulting and training positions either as employees or as independent entrepreneurs.

Vocational Qualification in Beauty Care, Beauty Therapist
Study Programme in Beauty Care

Beauty therapists work in establishments providing different cosmetic treatments as well as in sales and marketing, as independent self-employed people or as employees.

Vocational Qualification in Crafts and Design, Clothing Artisan
Vocational Qualification in Crafts and Design, Artisan, Handicraft Instructor
Study Programme in Textiles and Clothing Design and Production



Clothing artisans work in production assignments as craftspeople, self-employed or as employees, and in practical work assignments in design, repairs and restoration, guidance and counselling or customer services and marketing. Handicraft Instructors work in institutions, sheltered workshops, in the field of recreational activities, or as independent entrepreneurs.

Service Organisers work in customer service, serving, sales and cashier assignments e.g. in student and staff restaurants or catering and warming kitchens. Cooks (Institutional catering) work in cooking, storage, pre-processing and customer service assignments in e.g. student and staff restaurants, hospitals or central kitchens. Restaurant cooks work in restaurants, including staff and fast food restaurants, in catering business, as well as on passenger ships.

Preparatory Education, A Start for Vocational Education (20 – 40 credits)

The purpose of preparatory education is to give students knowledge of educational alternatives, different professions and working life, and to strengthen the skills required in vocational studies.

ACCOMMODATION AND SPARE TIME

The school has two student dormitories, one in Nivala and one in Pyhäjärvi. The flats have three furnished single or double rooms with a toilet and a shower as well as a shared kitchen.

The students are offered good opportunities to spend their free-time. Physical exercise facilities are excellent: swimming hall, ice skating hall, football and baseball fields etc. The outdoor recreation areas are well cared for, and the school's exercise and gym halls have plenty of modern equipment available for students. There are also numerous clubs for hobbies to fulfil the students' needs.

The studies for practical nurse take three years. The studies of the first two years consist of comprehensive vocational studies. After that you study a year taking educational programme studies accor-

Ylivieska Vocational College YSO



The town of Ylivieska serves as the administrative centre for Kajajokilaakso and Pyhäjokilaakso, an area with about 90,000 inhabitants. Ylivieska is also the commercial centre of the Oulu South region, the southern part of Oulu province. The population is about 14,000.

Ylivieska Vocational College (YSO) has about 400 students and 40 members of staff. It offers two vocational degree programmes, providing education for future practical nurses and media assistants. Since the beginning of 2006, YSO has an adult education department specialising in diverse fields such as customer service, catering, family day care, cleaning services (institutional cleaners, cleaning supervisors and cleaning technicians) as well as re-employment training. In addition, YSO offers labour market training in the fields of nursing and institutional cleaning.



STUDY PROGRAMMES

Diploma in Social and Health Care, Practical Nurse

The goal of the diploma studies is to give versatile information about the social and health care field for basic care work that demands theoretical background knowledge as well as mastery of various instruments and care methods.

Specialized vocational studies (3rd year):

- Mental Health and Substance Abuse Welfare Work
- Nursing and Care
- Care for the Disabled
- Care for the Elderly

The degree programme includes 37 credits of on-the-job learning taking place in e.g. day care centres, elderly people's homes, health centres and service homes. Part of these can be done abroad.

Diploma in Audiovisual Communications, Media Assistant

The goal of the audiovisual communications degree is to give an introduction to a media assistant's tasks. Everyone will get basic theoretical background to different areas of the audiovisual field;



image, light and sound technologies and media education before entering orientating studies.

The degree programme includes 20 credits of on-the-job learning, part of which can be done abroad.

AIKUKAM offers adult education and apprenticeship training services to develop the region's commercial and industrial life.

We arrange adult education and apprenticeship training as vocational additional education and re-education in cooperation with the educational federation as well as other colleges, working life centres and the commercial and industrial life of the region. The education is mostly degree-oriented, aimed at the adult population and answers to regional educational and developmental needs.

STUDY POSSIBILITIES

Adult education and apprenticeship training and their different manners of realisation are practical ways of obtaining vocational skills. In the education earlier qualifications and skills are taken into account. Studying is cheap and thanks to some financing channels even free of charge.

To enterprises we offer recruiting training and personnel training based on the needs of the enterprises themselves. Our expert participates in the mapping of skills when needed. We give aid in finding financing channels for the recruiting training and the personnel training.

In adult education and apprenticeship training you can study basic degrees, vocational degrees, special vocational degrees as well as non-degree-oriented additional training.

The colleges within the Educational Federation of the Kalajokilaakso Region mainly arrange the offered adult education. Also the theory teaching within the apprenticeship training as well as the skills demonstrations are arranged in these colleges as far as possible.
